## **PROJECT SUMMARY**

Global Civil and mining was contracted through Walyarra Contracting to supply Main Roads Kimberley with a Wirtgen 2500 Surface Miner to produce a sub base material for use on the Cape Leveque Road and the Derby Gibb River Road.

The work was undertaken prior to the wet season between November and December 2020.

A total of 32,284 m3 of material was produced for the Cape Leveque Road and 24,546 m3 was produced at the borrow pit SLK 68 on Derby Gibb River Road.

Key project objectives were:

- To produce suitable material for use on the roads;
- To only mill the gravel and separate the unsuitable material;
- To eliminate over excavation:
- To minimise, noise, dust and environmental impact.

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
